Burundi is the little sister country to Rwanda in East Africa. It isn't as famous for coffee as its neighbour but I think they might even be tastier!

Coffee arrived in Burundi in the 1930s and is now their leading export. What makes Burundi coffee quite unique is that their washed coffees are often "double fermented" meaning they spend a lot more time soaking in water which results in a super juicy and clean tasting cup.

Specialty coffees from Burundi are simply amazing and while they are hard to come by in Australia, when I can get my hands on some, I jump at the chance!

## ABOUT THE FARM/ESTATE

The coffees from Gaharo Hill are exceptionally delicious! Virtually all the coffee in this region (which is indeed a hillside) is of Bourbon varietal and all are harvested, pulped, fermented, washed, and patio dried to the same accuracy. The complexities in flavour – a true exploration of terroir – a word used to describe the soil, elevation, rainfall, temperature, and humidity.
