Brazil is the largest coffee producer in the world, contributing to over 30% of international coffee production. Because of this, coffee is one of Brazil's most valuable commodities.

The coffee industry is spread along 13 Brazilian states, with the largest and most notable in Sao Paulo, Minas Gerais and Rio de Janeiro.

Brazilian climate conditions don't quite match what would be deemed a 'perfect' climate for coffee production, but they still manage to product some excellent quality coffee.

Currently in Brazil, producers are investing in coffee production in areas with milder weather.

ABOUT THE FARM/ESTATE

The Fazenda Rio Verde farm is located at the centre of the Mantiqueira Mountain Range. This farm has been in operation for over 100 years.

This 900 hectare farm began coffee production in 1887 with the Junqueira family, who held ownership up until 2008. The farm is now owned by Ipanema Coffees, who still retain the founding family's legacies.
